Q1. Please note that HSDPA devices are on the FCC exclusion list as of several months ago. While some discussion about the existing HSDPA technology has occurred with the FCC, the latest FCC/TCBC teleconference has left HSDPA on the exclusions list. Please confirm if the HSDPA capability stated in the operational description applies to the FCC frequencies or if it applies to non-US frequencies only. Please note that if the HSDPA applies to US frequencies then the device may have to go directly to the FCC for certification.

A1. The FCC has excluded 3GPP Release 6 (HSUPA/HSDPA) implementations from TCB approval. Implementation in this device is 3GPP Release 5 (HSDPA) and therefore applicable to TCBs to approve.
