



1. Please note that the test result statement on the first page of the SAR report states that test results only apply to items tested. However, please note that the SAR report states that a fixture was used to provide the 1.5cm separation distance mentioned. It therefore must be assumed that as the test fixture was used no actual holster or belt clip was used to provide this distance. As such, the 1.5cm separation distance mentioned in the SAR report can only apply to holsters and/or belt clip that do not contain metal and that provides at least 1.5cm separation from the body during body worn application and not to any specific accessory. Since no actual holster or belt clip item was used a statement to this affect should be clearly provided in the report.

Please also note that as there is no indication in the SAR report that a specific holster or belt clip was used, the manual must then contain a caution statement which basically says "Body-worn operations are restricted to belt-clips, holsters or similar accessories that have no metallic component in the assembly and which provide at least 1.5 cm separation between the device and the users body." Please provide the caution statement in the manual that will address this no metal 1.5cm separation for holster/belt clips as mentioned in OET65C appendix D.
