#### **Duty Cycle Correction During 100msec**


Each function key sends a different series of characters, but each packet period (17.875msec) never exceeds a series of 4 long (1.5msec) and 10 short ( $500\mu sec$ ) pules. Assuming any combination of short and long pules may be obtained due to encoding the worse case transmit duty cycle would be considered  $4x1.5msec+10x500\mu sec$  per 17.875msec=61.5% duty cycle. Figure A through C show the characteristics of the pulse train for one of these function.

# Figure A [Pulse Train]











Rear View of the product
