I have a few comments on this Application.

1. FYI – no action needed. The 731 states a frequency range for this DTS device as 2400 to 2483.5MHz. Please note that the correct frequency range for Bluetooth devices such as this is 2402 to 2480MHz.
2. Please note that as this Bluetooth device is less than 25mw there is no need to include the 20cm separation distance in the manual. The only exposure notice needed is that the device complies with the rf exposure requirements of the FCC and OET65C. If the 20cm is left in the manual it may have to be also put on the grant whereas if only the compliance statement is in the manual the 20cm separation would not have to be on the grant. Please advise if you are going to change the separation statement to a simple rf compliance statement or if you are going to leave the statement as is.
