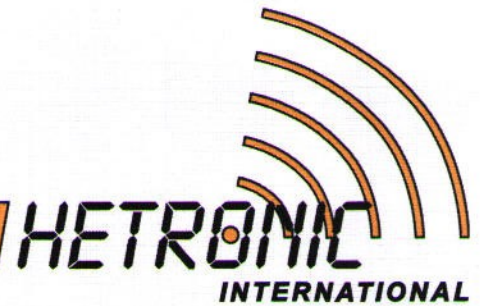

Please note that the Ergo F Transmitter will be packaged with the Battery Case not inserted on the battery compartment. This is to make sure that the label that shows the Transmitter's information (including FCC ID, IC ID, Model Name, Type, Frequency, Production No. and/or System No.) is clearly visible to the customer.

It is also worth noting that the label was strategically placed on the battery compartment to protect the label from getting damaged by the User and the environment. This transmitter is usually used for Industrial applications, outdoors and operators usually wear gloves which can damage the print or tear the label.
