Gentlemen - I have a filing for a 15.231 industrial remote control used exclusively with overhead cranes. It has an Emergency Stop switch which can be locked into continuous operation. Is this allowed under the provisions of 15.231(a)(4) where a device may operate during the pendency of the alarm condition? Best Regards, Bill

## Response:

If the emergency stop switch is locked into continuous transmission mode, only during an emergency situation, it is allowed. However, normal control of the crane may not be operated in continuous transmit mode.
