We, TagMaster AB, hereby authorize Intertek Semko AB, Sweden, to act as agent in the preparation of this application FCC ID: M39LRXX for equipment authorization to the Federal Communications Commission.

I certify that submitted Exhibits properly describe the device with FCC ID: M39LRXX.

This is to advise that we are in full compliance with the Anti-Drug Abuse Act. The applicant is not subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. 862, and no party to the application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to that section.

Due to 'last time buy' notification of a component used in the design, a minor update of the design has been made. This affects all products under the FCC ID: M39LRXX, namely S1566, LR-6 and HR-2. The modification is chip replacement of a portion of the transmitter that performs the sub function of frequency determination (PLL Synthesizer) in compliance to 'Part substitution' in the Permissive Change Policies. At the same time, the design was updated according to variations in electrical construction as of changing a micro processor and adding an additional receiver filter with corresponding amplifiers to meet European updated immunity requirements as of ETSI EN 301 489-1 v1.8.1. These changes meet the rules in Section 2.1043 as they do not affect stabilizing circuits, frequency multiplication, basic modulator or maximum power or field strength.

This affects the 612669 07 Schematic Diagram RF board.
