Hi Brian

I do not think your client understands the FCC position. Since no PC has been done on the device to either eliminate the DFS band 5250-5350MHz and since no PC has been done on the device to use this band in a client non-ad-hoc mode, the device is illegal to sell. You cannot simply say, we won't use the band, a PC one way or the other (i.e. providing DFS test results in client mode for the DFS band, or removing the band altogether from the grant) **MUST BE DONE** before any other PC can be done.

Please inform your client that if they are still selling this device without this PC, regardless if any comment is in the manual or not, they are marketing an illegal device.

Please either provide PC to remove the DFS bands or please provide DFS test results applicable to keep the DFS bands. This can be done on this PC, but you must still provide the appropriate data and information.
