
Care & safety precautions

- During charging, keep your device and charger near room temperature for efficient battery charging.
- Never batteries are not fully charged.
- Never batteries are recharged for a long time may take more time to charge.
- The included charger is intended for indoor use only.
- Do not use the tablet in rain or other wet locations.
- Never attempt to disassemble, repair or modify the tablet yourself.
- Do not use the tablet on or near open flames.
- Avoid pulling any liquid on the tablet.
- Use the tablet with care, using all cables and run off the tablet.
- Do not attempt to by the tablet with an external power source.
- Unplug all cables and turn off the tablet before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the tablet and display.
- Avoid getting moisture in open ports.
- Do not use household cleaners, solvents, alcohol, or abrasives to clean the tablet.
- Always use the tablet in a proper and safe condition. If there is any damage or broken parts, remove the tablet from use.
- If any reason the tablet is damaged or broken, immediately remove the product from use and contact Customer Support.
- It is not possible for sources to be triggered by light flashes or patterns such as those on computer or TV screens. To reduce exposure to this potential hazard, always maintain a safe distance from the screen and take 10- to 15-minute breaks every hour.
- Cords could be a strangulation hazard.





Charging

Connect the tablet to a wall outlet using the included charger and USB charging cable as shown below.



When charging, the lightning indicator will appear in the battery icon.




Battery Tips:


- Turn off Wi-Fi when it's not in use.
- Lock the tablet (turning the display off) to shorten charging time.
- To optimize battery time and performance, adjust the "Brightness" and "Screen timeout" options in the Settings panel.
- It is recommended to keep the brightness level at 50% or under if the tablet is in use while charging.

Power ON / OFF


Turning on the tablet
Press & hold the Power button until the startup screen appears.




Power off the tablet
Press & hold the Power button until the "Power off" option appears.



Lock the tablet (standby)
Briefly press the Power button. (Lock the tablet to conserve the battery).




Unlock the tablet
Briefly press the Power button, and slide the "Lock icon" up.




Initial Setup

- 3 To use the Google Play store, sign into or create a Google account.




Home screen



Press and hold widgets to place them on the home screen as shown below.




Press  icon on the home screen to access the Apps Screen.



Notifications and Quick Settings


Notifications panel

Quick Settings panel



To enable/disable Wi-Fi or Bluetooth™, simply tap the icons on the Quick Settings panel as shown below.





Inserting a Micro SD card


The tablet supports Micro SD cards up to 64GB (not included). To install a Micro SD card into the tablet, carefully insert the card as shown below into the card slot until it clicks and locks into place.

To remove the Micro SD card, gently press it inward to eject.



Transferring files


- 1 Connect the tablet to the computer using the included USB charging cable as shown below.
- 2 Tap the "USB for charging" notification on the tablet screen.
- 3 Select "File transfers".
- 4 The internal storage of the tablet will appear on your PC.



Reset

If the tablet malfunctions or freezes, you can use the reset button to restart it. To reset the tablet, take a metal pin (such as the end of a paper clip) and gently push the recessed reset button on the side of the tablet as shown below.

The tablet will restart.


