




















4.6 BAND EDGES MEASUREMENT

NOTE:

1.The calibration interval of the above test instruments is 12 months and the calibrations are traceable to NML/ROC and NIST/USA.

4.6.3 TEST PROCEDURE

The transmitter output was connected to the spectrum analyzer via a low lose cable. Set both RBW and VBW of spectrum analyzer to 1MHz and 300Hz with suitable frequency span including 100 MHz bandwidth from band edge. The band edges was measured and recorded.

4.6.5 TEST RESULTS (A)

The spectrum plots are attached on the following 4 pages. D1 line indicates the highest level, D2 line indicates the 20dB offset below D1. It shows compliance with the requirement in part 15.247(C).

Test Mode A

NOTE (1): The band edge emission plot on the following 1 \sim 2 page shows 58.33dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.3900GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.8 is 105.1dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 105.1-58.33=46.77dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.


NOTE (2): The band edge emission plot on the following $3 \sim 4$ page shows 57.36dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.4835GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.8 is 105.2dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 105.2-57.36=47.84dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.

Test Mode B


NOTE (1): The band edge emission plot on the following 1 \sim 2 page shows 58.33dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.3900GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.8 is 102.7dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 102.7-58.33=44.37dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.

NOTE (2): The band edge emission plot on the following $3 \sim 4$ page shows 57.36dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.4835GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.8 is 106.0dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 106.0-57.36=48.64dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.





















4.6.6 TEST RESULTS (B)

The spectrum plots are attached on the following 4 pages. D1 line indicates the highest level, D2 line indicates the 20dB offset below D1. It shows compliance with the requirement in part 15.247(C).

Test Mode A

NOTE (1): The band edge emission plot on the following $1 \sim 2$ page shows $46.39 \, \text{dB}$ delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.3900GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.9 is $99.8 \, \text{dBuV/m}$, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is $99.8 \, \text{d} \cdot 39 = 53.41 \, \text{dBuV/m}$ which is under $54 \, \text{dBuV/m}$ limit.


NOTE (2): The band edge emission plot on the following 3 ~ 4 page shows 44.12dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.4835GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.9 is 97.3dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 97.3-44.12=53.18dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.

Test Mode B


NOTE (1): The band edge emission plot on the following 1 \sim 2 page shows 46.39dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.3900GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.9 is 99.3dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 99.3-46.39=52.91dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.

NOTE (2): The band edge emission plot on the following $3 \sim 4$ page shows 44.12dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.4835GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.9 is 97.5dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 97.5-44.12=53.38dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.





















4.7 **ANTENNA REQUIREMENT**

4.7.1 STANDARD APPLICABLE

For intentional device, according to FCC 47 CFR Section 15.203, an intentional radiator shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party shall be used with the device.

And according to FCC 47 CFR Section 15.247 (b), if transmitting antennas of directional gain greater than 6dBi are used, the power shall be reduced by the amount in dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6dBi.

4.7.2 ANTENNA CONNECTED CONSTRUCTION

The antenna types used in this product are PIFA Antenna and Lambda/4 PIFI Antenna with HRS connector And the maximum Gain of this antenna is only 0.6dBi.


