## **Module Approval Request Letter**

**We, Ambit Microsystems Corporation's Wireless module with antennas BY27, ZG1S and ZI1S, installed in ACER notebook PC , FCC ID:MCLT60M665, would like to apply for Limited Modular approval.**

**We declare that T60M665 meet the following requirement of FCC Public Notice DA00-1407.**

1. The modular transmitter must have its own RF shielding.
2. The modular transmitter must have buffered modulation/data inputs.
3. The modular transmitter must comply with the antenna requirements of Section 15.203 and 15.204(c). The antenna must either be permanently attached or employ a "unique" antenna coupler (at all connections between the module and the antenna, including the cable). Any antenna used with the module must be approved with the module, either at the time of initial authorization or through a Class II permissive change. The "professional installation" provision of Section 15.203 may not be applied to modules.
4. The FCC ID number will be labeled on the host notebook PC.
