2. TEST METHODOLOGY

The tests documented in this report were performed in accordance with ANSI C63.10-2009, FCC CFR 47 Part 2, FCC CFR 47 Part 15, RSS-GEN Issue 3, and RSS-210 Issue 8.

3. FACILITIES AND ACCREDITATION

The test sites and measurement facilities used to collect data are located at 47173 Benicia Street, Fremont, California, USA.

4. CALIBRATION AND UNCERTAINTY

4.1. MEASURING INSTRUMENT CALIBRATION

The measuring equipment utilized to perform the tests documented in this report has been calibrated in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, and is traceable to recognized national standards.

4.2. SAMPLE CALCULATION

Where relevant, the following sample calculation is provided:

Field Strength (dBuV/m) = Measured Voltage (dBuV) + Antenna Factor (dB/m) + Cable Loss (dB) – Preamp Gain (dB) 36.5 dBuV + 18.7 dB/m + 0.6 dB – 26.9 dB = 28.9 dBuV/m

4.3. MEASUREMENT UNCERTAINTY

Where relevant, the following measurement uncertainty levels have been estimated for tests performed on the apparatus:

5.1. DESCRIPTION OF EUT

The EUT is WIFI Module with 802.11B/G/HT20.

The radio module is manufactured by Hon Hai Precision.

5.3. DESCRIPTION OF AVAILABLE ANTENNAS

The radio utilizes a PiFA antenna for TX/RX diversity, with maximum peak gains of 2.05dBi

5.4. SOFTWARE AND FIRMWARE

The EUT test utility software installed in the host computer during testing was Broadcom test program BCM43362SDGN6L version 5.90.104 WLTEST

5.5. WORST-CASE CONFIGURATION AND MODE

The worst-case data rate for each mode is determined to be as follows, based on preliminary tests of the chipset utilized in this radio.

All final tests in the 802.11b mode were made at 1 Mb/s.

All final tests in the 802.11g mode were made at 6 Mb/s.

All final tests in the 802.11n HT20 SISO mode were made at MCS0.

For radiated emissions below 1 GHz the worst-case configuration is determined to be the mode and channel with the highest output power

To determine the worst-position of highest emissions, the EUT's antenna was investigated for X, Y, Z positions, and the worst position was turned out to be a Y-position with long ends at left side.




SPURIOUS EMISSIONS, LOW CHANNEL







SPURIOUS EMISSIONS, MID CHANNEL


SPURIOUS EMISSIONS, LOW CHANNEL







SPURIOUS EMISSIONS, MID CHANNEL


SPURIOUS EMISSIONS, LOW CHANNEL







SPURIOUS EMISSIONS, MID CHANNEL

TEST PROCEDURE

The EUT is placed on a non-conducting table 80 cm above the ground plane. The antenna to EUT distance is 3 meters. The EUT is configured in accordance with ANSI C63.4. The EUT is set to transmit in a continuous mode.

For measurements below 1 GHz the resolution bandwidth is set to 100 kHz for peak detection measurements or 120 kHz for quasi-peak detection measurements. Peak detection is used unless otherwise noted as quasi-peak.

For measurements above 1 GHz the resolution bandwidth is set to 1 MHz, and then the video bandwidth is set to 1 MHz for peak measurements and 10 Hz for average measurements.


The spectrum from 30 MHz to 26 GHz is investigated with the transmitter set to the lowest, middle, and highest channels in the 2.4 GHz band.


The frequency range of interest is monitored at a fixed antenna height and EUT azimuth. The EUT is rotated through 360 degrees to maximize emissions received. The antenna is scanned from 1 to 4 meters above the ground plane to further maximize the emission. Measurements are made with the antenna polarized in both the vertical and the horizontal positions.





RESTRICTED BANDEDGE (LOW CHANNEL, VERTICAL)







RESTRICTED BANDEDGE (HIGH CHANNEL, HORIZONTAL)







RESTRICTED BANDEDGE (LOW CHANNEL, VERTICAL)







RESTRICTED BANDEDGE (HIGH CHANNEL, HORIZONTAL)
