Overview

This application is for a limited modular approval of a GSM cellular modem, Model WMP100, FCC ID: MCQ-WMPX5F. This device will be installed in vehicle-mounted telematics gateway, Model X5 Fleet. The WMP100 will be co-located in the host device with 3 other previously approved radio modules, FCC IDS: MCQ-XBEEPRO2, MCQ-50M1589 and an Orbcomm Leo Satellite Transceiver, which operated under an Orbcomm blanket license, FCC Call Sign E940534, 10 FCC Red 6572 (1995).

Test reports and technical exhibits demonstrate compliance with FCC Parts 22H and 24E. A Cetecom test report is submitted for the Wavecom WMP100, FCC ID:O9EWMP100 for antenna direct connect measurements, while the Northwest EMC report shows radiated emission measurements. The Wavecom model WMP100 and the Digi Model WMP100 are electrically and mechanically identical.

This device is considered a mobile device for RF Exposure considerations.
