## 5.0 Labeling Requirements

## 5.1 FCC ID Label and Placement




FIGURE 3 - Drawing Showing Location of FCC ID and Placement

All information on the label will be etched or screened. All methods will exceed the expected lifetime of the equipment.

The label will be large enough to allow all information to be readily legible.

The Labelling Requirements of 15.19(c) shall appear in the Owners Manual.

## 5.1 FCC ID Label and Placement (Continued)

Label will be constructed of 0.02 inch plastic attached as shown on the equipment with permanent adhesive. To protect the ID label, the area where the FCC ID number is installed is below the surface of the back of the case. This keeps the label from being "peeled" off. All information on the label will be etched or screened. All methods will exceed the expected lifetime of the equipment. The label will be large enough to allow all information to be readily legible.


## 5.2 Additional Labels Required

This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) This device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.

Shown above is a copy of the label with the Part 15.19 Compliance Statement, Location of required information is checked "below".



The label will be placed in a conspicuous location on the device.



The device is too small for a compliance label. The label will be placed on the container in which the device will be marketed.
