

Panasonic Remote Control Quick Reference Guide

Setup

1. Insert 2 AA battery (Heavy duty is supplied with remote or Alkaline, not lithium battery)

CONTROLLING YOUR TV

- 1. Press Power key to turn on the TV
- 2. Set TV for pairing mode via menu
- 3. Press and hold <Home> and <Option Key> on the remote to pairing remote with TV

Touchpad

1. Allow 360 degrees control for menu navigation
