Question #2: Modification #2 Ferrite bead was added to the external RJ45 cable. Ferrite bead is considered as special accessory under 15.27 of FCC rules. Please provide a marketing statement and signed by the Grantee to indicate that clamp-on type of ferrite bead will be sold with the unit. In addition, a brief description to be included in the user manual to instruct the end user how to apply this clamp on type ferrite bead on the RJ45 cable to ensure product compliance. Please provide such marketing statement and revised user manual.

Question #3 Schematic diagram can not be read. Please provide a clear copy of schematic diagram

Question #4: Output power : In accordance to FCC DSSS test procedure, when making conducted output power measurement, the RBW shall be greater than 6dB bandwidth. The bandwidth used in making the measurement is 3MHz which is less than 6dB bandwidth. If the 3MHz RBW is the limitation of Spectrum Analyzer, please make the measurement with peak power meter and submit revised test report.
