Subject: Extended Frequencies Justification:

To aid equipment authorization in other countries that accepts the FCC Certification Grant, Midland Radio Corporation. requests that the FCC list the frequencies 764 to 775 MHz for Rule Part 90 on the grant.

For Rule Part 90 applications, this radio is used in systems by Federal and Public Safety agencies including Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services, as indicated in the table below.
