Operating instructions for this system, named Engine Immobilizer System, will be contained in the owner's manual of the vehicle and its contents will be as follows:

ENGINE IMMOBILIZER SYSTEM

The engine immobilizer system is a theft prevention system. When you insert the key in the ignition switch, the transponder chip in the key's head transmits an electronic code to the vehicle. The engine will start, only when the electronic code in the chip corresponds to the registered ID code for the vehicle.

The system is automatically set when the key is removed from the ignition switch. Inserting the registered key in the ignition switch automatically cancels the system, which enables the engine to start.

For your Toyota dealer to make you a new key with build-in transponder chip, your dealer will need your key number and master key. However, there is a limit to the number of additional keys your Toyota dealer can make for you.

If you make your own duplicate key, you will not be able to cancel the system or start the engine.
