Dear Mr. Coperich:

I realize that user's manuals are not eligible for confidential status but the reason for my requesting it in this particular application is because of the fact that when the original application was submitted, all documents were included in the technical manual which means they are all accessible by opening the technical manual.

I have taken the technical manual and removed the schematics and bill of materials; I am uploading the technical manual with these items removed and I am uploading the schematics and bill of materials separately.

Adcon also understands that the application has already been approved and there was a time period that the technical manual may have been accessed. In their letter requesting confidentiality, they stated that they would not hold anyone responsible during that time period.

Before electronic filing, when the exhibits were not available over the internet, my customer did not worry as much about other's viewing their schematics etc. But once it became so readily available over the internet, they asked me to file for confidentiality. I was told we could do this by filing a Class II Permissive change. I followed those instructions.

In the future, Adcon will request confidentiality on all applications filed. I have also been told, recently, that we cannot include one technical manual which contains all of the exhibits. We do not do this anymore.

Adcon wishes confidentiality due to marketing purposes.

I hope this satisfies all requirements for this request for confidentiality.
