| | X | | Stationary Mode | Transmitter enters mode after First 36 Block (BMT) Drive Mode or 1min Drive Mode - Wheel is not rotating - Vehicle is stopped. | Park mode (stationary transmission) every 13hours |
| | X | | First 36 Block BMT (Drive Mode) | Enters mode upon exiting Stationary mode for first 36 transmissions. This mode is a function to learn the sensor IDs to confirm wheel positions on vehicle. | Transmission rate every 15secs |
