I have a few comments on this Application.

- 1 Intentional radiators must be tested up to the tenth harmonic of the fundamental. The plots of radiated emissions show that around 8 to 10 GHz the noise floor of the analyzer is over the limit. It is not possible in this condition to determine if the tenth harmonic of the device is compliant. Please provide evidence that the device is compliant up to the tenth harmonic. xxx
- 2 The manual must contain a caution statement in accordance with 15.21 Information to user. (The users manual or instruction manual for an intentional or unintentional radiator shall caution the user that changes or modifications not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.) Please correct the manual to include this no modification statement. xx
- 3 The manual must contain the necessary information to the user in accordance with 15.105. For class B devices in the home environment this statement must be in accordance with 15.105(b). Please correct the manual to include this statement. xx
- 4 Please note that the request for confidentiality must refer to each specific document to be held confidential and must be signed. The request for confidentiality provided has two items listed (etc, can not be used to include additional items), however, other documentation lists several other items. Please provide a request for confidentiality that specifically lists those items to be confidential. Please note that only certain items can be confidential. These include block diagrams, schematics, theory of operation, and parts lists. xx
