I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) The manual does not appear to contain the required SAR language and SAR values. Please review.
- 2.) This FCC ID will refer to this entire PC with both Bluetooth and WLAN transmitters installed. It will not be valid in configurations when only WLAN or Bluetooth are present. FCC rules do not permit "depopulating" a device which contains two transmitters. AmericanTCB recommends that you discuss this issue and provide an attestation letter signed by the Applicant indicating their understanding.
- 3.) Page 30 of "UltraMobile PC" manual seems to indicate that this device can also operate under 802.11a (5GHz). Please review and comment.
- 4.) Page 31 of Manual appears to suggest that the Bluetooth transceiver is user installable. Is this true?
- 5.) Is the end user allowed to set wireless channel operation for different domains?
- 6.) Please note that SAR values must appear in the Manual.
- 7.) The SAR probe appears to be out of calibration. All equipment associated with SAR testing must be calibrated on a yearly basis.
