- 1) The cover letter information provided is good supporting information. However a cover letter should be provided which explains the differences and the reasons for them. In addition, it should explain how these changes meet with 2.1043 and is also helpful if it explains which tests were evaluated. Please provide.
- 2) From previous discussion on this device, it was also supposed to include SAR data, SAR data which was worse. The data provided earlier in emails for discussion was sufficient for the configurations tested, however this information needed to be incorporated into a normal SAR report for final submittal. Please provide.
- 3) Digital Device emissions should have been retested. These may have been included as part of the PC peripheral emissions, or as a separate digital device test. Please provide and/or explain.
