




Test plot (GFSK)

Transmit Freq Error 25.049 kHz x dB Bandwidth 874.230 kHz






20dB Bandwidth (CH Low)




Band Edges (CH-Low)




Detector mode: Average Polarity: Vertical




Polarity: Horizontal Detector mode: Average






Polarity: Horizontal Detector mode: Average









Polarity: Vertical Detector mode: Average

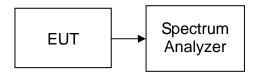





20 dB bandwidth(CH High)




Transmit Freq Error 18.992 kHz x dB Bandwidth 877.704 kHz




Test Plot (GFSK)




Test Plot (8DPSK)






Test Plot 8DPSK





6.8 SPURIOUS EMISSIONS




CH Mid




CH High





6.9 POWERLINE CONDUCTED EMISSIONS

<u>LIMIT</u>

For an intentional radiator which is designed to be connected to the public utility (AC) power line, the radio frequency voltage that is conducted back onto the AC power line on any frequency or frequencies within the band 150 kHz to 30 MHz shall not exceed 250 microvolts (The limit decreases linearly with the logarithm of the frequency in the range 0.15 MHz to 0.50 MHz). The limits at specific frequency range is listed as follows:



The initial step in collecting conducted data is a spectrum analyzer peak scan of the measurement range. Significant peaks are then marked as shown on the following data page, and these signals are then quasi-peaked.
