I have a few comments on this Application.

1. Please note that this is a PCMCIA card used in notebooks and laptop computers. As such it is classified as a portable device. Also, SAR has been done on this device. Please note that the 20 separation distance statement in your manual is incorrect as it is for mobile devices. Please provide the appropriate SAR compliance statement in the manual. x
2. Please note that the manual states this device is also to be used/sold in the EU countries. The FCC has stated that "Section 15.15(b) prohibits adjustments of any control by the user that will cause operation of a device in violation of the regulations. Accordingly, any proposal to allow the end user to choose extended channels on frequencies outside of an allowable frequency band in the USA is not acceptable." Please note that channels 12 through 14 are not allowed in the US. Please verify that the channels 12 through 14 are not software or otherwise selectable for the version sold in the US and that only channels 1 through 11 are capable of being used on the device sold in the US. x
3. Please note that the SAR report states that 50mW was used in system validation. Please note that the FCC has recently stated that sufficient power (at least 100mW) should be used during system validation. Please verify and show how the use of 50mW was sufficient to meet the verification requirements for SAR system validation. x
