- 2. Above 1 GHz, the channel 1, 6, and 11 were tested individually.
- 3. Data rate 11Mbps, the worst case, was chosen for final test.



4.1.3 TEST PROCEDURES

- a. The EUT was placed 0.4 meters from the conducting wall of the shielded room with EUT being connected to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (LISN). Other support units were connected to the power mains through another LISN. The two LISNs provide 50 ohm/ 50uH of coupling impedance for the measuring instrument.
- b. Both lines of the power mains connected to the EUT were checked for maximum conducted interference.
- c. The frequency range from 150 kHz to 30 MHz was searched. Emission levels over 10dB under the prescribed limits could not be reported

4.1.4 TEST SETUP



Note: 1. Support units were connected to second LISN.

2. Both of LISNs (AMIN) 80 cm from EUT and at the least 80 cm from other units and other metal planes support units.

4.1.5 EUT OPERATING CONDITIONS

- a. Placed the EUT on the testing table.
- b. The computer system sent data to EUT by command "PIN" via an RJ 45 cable.
- c. The computer system sent "H" messages to Color Monitor and Monitor displayed "H" patterns on its screen.
- d. The computer system sent "H" messages to modem.
- e. The computer system sent "H" messages to printer, and the printer prints them on paper.
- f. Prepared another computer system to act as a communication partner and placed it outside of testing area.
- g. The communication partner run a test program to enable EUT under transmission/receiving condition continuously at specific channel frequency via an RJ 45 cable.
- h. The communication partner sent data to EUT by command "PIN".



4.2.1 LIMITS OF RADIATED EMISSION MEASUREMENT

4.2.3 TEST PROCEDURES

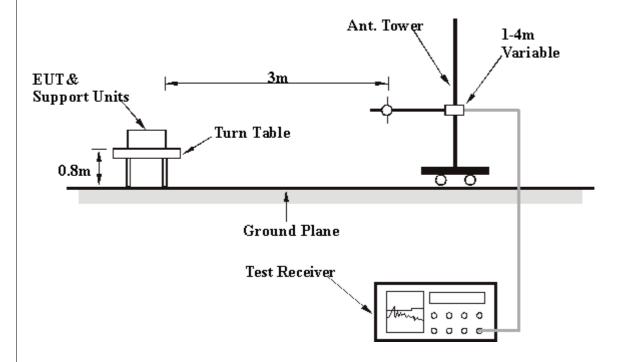
- a. The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 0.8 meters above the ground at a 10 meter open area test site. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- b. The EUT was set 3 meters away from the interference-receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable-height antenna tower.
- c. The antenna is a broadband antenna, and its height is varied from one meter to four meters above the ground to determine the maximum value of the field strength. Both horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement.
- d. For each suspected emission, the EUT was arranged to its worst case and then the antenna was tuned to heights from 1 meter to 4 meters and the rotatable table was turned from 0 degrees to 360 degrees to find the maximum reading.
- e. The test-receiver system was set to Peak Detect Function and Specified Bandwidth with Maximum Hold Mode.
- f. If the emission level of the EUT in peak mode was 10 dB lower than the limit specified, then testing could be stopped and the peak values of the EUT would be reported. Otherwise the emissions that did not have 10 dB margin would be re-tested one by one using peak, quasi-peak or average method as specified and then reported in a data sheet.

NOTE:

- 1. The resolution bandwidth and video bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 120kHz for Peak detection (PK) and Quasi-peak detection (QP) at frequency below 1GHz.
- 2. The resolution bandwidth and video bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 1 MHz for Peak detection at frequency above 1GHz.
- 3. The resolution bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 1 MHz and the video bandwidth is 300 Hz for Average detection (AV) at frequency above 1GHz.

NOTE: The band edge emission plot on the following 2 pages shows 52.34dB / 52.62dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.3878GHz / 2.4910GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.6 (Page 24) is 96.9dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 96.9-52.34=44.56dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.
