

1. The EUT was pretested with 3 orientations placed on the table for the radiated emission measurement – X, Y, and Z-plane. The **X-plane** results were found as the worst case and were shown in this report.

2. Adapter 1, Adapter 2 and Adapter 3 had been pretested and found that **Adapter 1** was the worst case and was selected for final testing (Adapter 1: AOEM adapter; Adapter 2: APD adapter; Adapter 3: MOSO adapter).



# 3 Test Results

# 3.1 Effective Radiated Power

#### 3.1.1 Limit of Effective Radiated Power

The ERP of mobile transmitters and auxiliary test transmitters must not exceed 7 Watts.

#### 3.1.2 Test Procedures

For Conducted power measurement

- 1. The EUT links up with simulator and is set to maximum output power level at low / middel / high channel.
- 2. Measure the output power of low / middle / high channel of the EUT


#### For ERP measurement

EPR can be calculated by below formula from KDB 412172 D01

- 1. ERP = EIRP 2.15 dB.
- 2. EIRP =  $P_T + G_T L_C$ 
  - $P_T$  = transmitter output power, in dBm
  - $G_T$  = gain of the transmitting antenna, in dBi (EIRP)
  - $L_{C}$  = signal attenuation in the connecting cable between the transmitter and antenna, in dB.

# 3.2 Radiated Emissions

#### 3.2.1 Limit of Radiated Emissions


The power of any emission outside of the authorized operating frequency ranges must be attenuated below the transmitting power (P) by a factor of at least  $43 + 10 \log(P) dB$  equal to -13dBm.

#### 3.2.2 Test Procedures

- 1. Measurement is made at a semi-anechoic chamber that incorporates a turntable allowing a EUT rotation of 360°. A continuously-rotating, remotely-controlled turntable is installed at the test site to support the EUT and facilitate determination of the direction of maximum radiation for each EUT emission frequency. The EUT is placed at a height of 0.8 m test table above the ground plane.
- Measurement is made with the antenna positioned in both the horizontal and vertical planes of polarization. The measurement antenna is varied in height (1m ~ 4m) above the reference ground plane to obtain the maximum signal strength. Distance between EUT and antenna is 3 m.
- This investigation is performed with the EUT rotated 360°, the antenna height scanned between 1 m and 4 m, and the antenna rotated to repeat the measurements for both the horizontal and vertical antenna polarizations.
- 4. After finding the max radiated emission, substitution method will be used for getting effective radiated power. EUT will be removed and substitution antenna will be placed at same position. Signal generator will output CW signal to substitution antenna through a RF cable. Rotate turntable and move antenna to find maximum radiated emission. Adjust output power of signal generator to let the maximum radiated emission is same as step 3. Record the output power level.
- E.I.R.P = output power of step 4 + gain of substitution antenna cable loss of RF cable. ERP can be calculated by below formula: E.R.P= E.I.R.P – 2.15dB


#### 3.3.1 Limit of Conducted Emissions

The power of any emission outside of the authorized operating frequency ranges must be attenuated below the transmitting power (P) by a factor of at least  $43 + 10 \log(P) dB$  equal to -13dBm.

#### 3.3.2 Test Procedures


- 1. Lowest, middle and highest operating channels are tested for this item.
- 2. Scan frequency range is from 30MHz~9GHz.
- 3. Set RBW = 1MHz, VBW = 3MHz, detector = RMS, sweep time = auto.
- 4. Record the max trace value and capture the test plot of each sub frequency band.





- 2. The center frequency of spectrum analyzer will be set to 824 and 849 MHz.
- 3. Set RBW = VBW = 100kHz, span = 5 MHz, detector = RMS, sweep time = auto




# 3.5 Occupied and 26 dB Bandwidth

#### 3.5.1 Test Procedures

- 1. Set resolution bandwidth (RBW) = 100 kHz, Video bandwidth = 300 kHz
- 2. Detector = Peak, Trace mode = max hold.
- 3. Sweep = auto couple, Allow the trace to stabilize.
- 4. Using occupied bandwidth measurement function of spectrum analyzer to measure occupied bandwidth
- 5. Measure the maximum width of the emission that is constrained by the frequencies associated with the two outermost amplitude points (upper and lower) that are attenuated by 26dB relative to the maximum level measured in the fundamental emission.


#### 3.6.1 Limit of Peak to Average Ratio

Peak-to-average ratio (PAR) of the transmission may not exceed 13 dB

#### 3.6.2 Test Procedures

- 1. Enable CCDF function of spectrum analyzer and set RBW=10MHz
- 2. Set the number of counts to a value that stabilizes the measured CCDF curve
- 3. Record the maximum PAPR level associated with a probability of 0.1%.




### 3.7.1 Limit of Frequency Stability

The frequency stability shall be less +/- 2.5ppm.

### 3.7.2 Test Procedures

- 1. EUT was placed at temperature chamber and connected to an external power supply.
- 2. Temperature and voltage condition shall be tested to confirm frequency stability.
- 3. Temperature range is from -30~50°C and voltage range is from lowest to highest working voltage.
- 4. Link up EUT and simulator. Confirm frequency drift value of simulator and record it.
