

U.S. Agent for Service of Process – Service Period

Approve-IT, Inc. is offering US Agent for Service of Process to manufacturers that require an in-country representative to help facilitate the FCC certification and SDoC processes.

By rule, our US Agent Letters cannot expire, and the language that we use in our letters clearly state that the letters are valid indefinitely.

The Applicant confirms its explicit consent and acknowledges that they must maintain an agent for no less than one year after terminating all marketing and importation OR the conclusion of any Commission-related proceeding involving the equipment. The applicant further acknowledges their responsibility to inform the FCC whenever the Designated U.S. Agent information above changes.

However, Approve-IT does limit the service period to a defined time range in which each letter may be uploaded to the FCC website. Our service period is designed to allow manufacturers to choose service options limited to a single FCC ID, or use of a letter for all applications under a grantee code, allowing manufacturers the flexibility required to suit their individual needs. The service period considers the fact that multiple uses of each letter may be required for permissive changes or other modifications, and thus we offer 1-year and 5-year service options to allow multiple uses of the letter. These options are selected with the consideration that few or many uses of each letter may be required.

We ask that our US Agent Letter template continue to be accepted, for the benefit of the manufacturers that hire our services.
