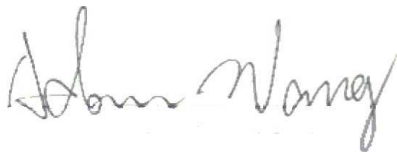

WiMAX, with its scheduling protocol, currently stands as the main example of a restricted contention technology. Different WiMAX systems can be coordinated to avoid interfering with each other, thus providing each WiMAX device a "reasonable opportunity to operate."
