Here is the information you have requested:

- 1) I have corrected the confidentiality request letter to include the internal photographs and attached it as updated\_confidentiality\_letter.pdf.
- 2) The reason AirNet requests that the internal photographs be held confidential is to try to prevent competitors from gaining access to this data. The photographs contain technology and design information which is proprietary to AirNet. To that extent, AirNet's customers are under a non-disclosure agreements with AirNet. This prevents them from distributing photographs of the equipment. Certain components, such as the amplifiers, have their warranty voided if the cover is removed by unauthorized personnel which also discourages the user from opening these modules and photographing them.
- 3) The attached updated\_confidentiality\_letter.pdf gives reference to this type of request being previously granted for airNet.
