As per your request of June 9, 2000, we would like to amend our request for confidentiality to read as follows:

Wild Planet Toys, Inc. is in the business of designing, manufacturing, and marketing of toys for children. Our market to these children is worldwide and it is extremely competitive. It is not uncommon for our competition to attempt to copy our products and market them under there own names.

Wild Planet Toys, Inc. considers design information for its products to be trade secrets and does not normally make this information available to 3<sup>rd</sup> parties other than the manufactures of the products. These manufactures are in turn bound by non- disclosure agreements with Wild Planet Toys, Inc.

If information regarding the design of our Radio DJ were to be released to the public, it would make it much easier for the product to be copied and this could cause our company substantial competitive harm.

Due to this risk of being copied by others, we specifically request that the following documents of our application be withheld from the public:

Radio DJ Block.PDF (Radio DJ Block Diagram) Radio DJ Circuit.PDF (Radio DJ Schematic Diagram) Radio DJ Description.PDF (Radio DJ Circuit Description) Radio DJ BOM.PDF (Radio DJ Bill of Materials)

We believe that the Radio DJ will have a product life of at least 5 years and would therefore request that the above documents should not be available for public disclosure for a period of 5 years.
