Sierra Wireless is submitting an application for Class II Permissive Change to our wireless module, model MC7700 (FCC ID: N7NMC7700), originally certified on May 31, 2011.

The changes filed under this application are as follows:

- To enable the 15MHz and 20 MHz bandwidth operations in LTE Band 4 through a firmware update.

There is no hardware or electrical modification made to the modular transmitter itself. It has been verified that the conducted power of the 15MHz and 20 MHz bandwidth operations in LTE Band 4 does not exceed the maximum conducted power in Band 4 as reported to the Commission in the original filing, therefore there's no impact to the MPE report or the radiated spurious emission report.
