#### Friis Formula

Friis transmission formula :  $Pd = (Pout*G)/(4*pi*r^2)$ 

Where

 $Pd = power density in mW/cm^2$ 

Pout = output power to antenna in mW

G = gain of antenna in linear scale

Pi = 3.1416

R = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd id the limit of MPE, 1 mW/cm2. If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.

The power density Pd (4<sup>th</sup> column) at a distance of 20cm calculated from the Friis transmission formula is far belowthe limit of 1 mW/cm<sup>2</sup>. So, RF exposure limit warning or SAR test are not required.
