I have a few comments on this Application.

1. The manual and FCD ID label information and setup photos clearly identifies this as a modular device. Please provide the modular request letter.
2. Please note, the manual states that this device is not to be collocated with any other transmitter or antenna. However, the manual also clearly shows the device used in conjunction with a Cell phone. Since 20 cm is the typical distance where collocation issues are considered to begin, the use in the cell phone would potentially be collocation. This device EIRP is 7.6mW and as such cannot be used in a portable configuration with collocated antenna(s) without certification by the FCC. Please explain or resolve the conflicting collocation issues with this manual.
3. Please note that modules are OEM installed. The use with the cell phone as stated in the manual would appear to violate this intent. Please explain how this device would be OEM installed in this situation.
4. Please note that the manual states this device can be used in a point to point 'connection pattern'. Please note that this device has an integral antenna and is not capable of point to point use. Please clarify what the manual means in section 2.4 pertaining to cell phone and point to point use.
