Re: Class II Permissive change

This letter serves as notice that Novatel Wireless is requesting a Class II permissive change on the EU850D device. The reason for the Class II permissive change is the addition of a Subscriber Interface Module (SIM) connector that is located on top of this product which penetrates the RF shield that was featured in the original design, the EU870D.

The EU870D features the SIM connector on the end of the product. Novatel Wireless has submitted artwork that illustrates the changes between the EU870D and the EU850D.
