Re: Declaration of IMEI Security

Dear Sirs:

We declare that Novatel Wireless, Inc. has taken necessary and sufficient steps to ensure that the 'Ovation MC547' and 'Ovation MC545' USB Modems complies with the relevant IMEI security and integrity requirements expressed in GSM standards 02.07; 02.09; 02.16; 03.03 and 3GPP 51.010-1.

The IMEI number assigned to each unit is unique and is only assigned to the models described above. The IMEI number is factory set and a unique number is assigned to each unit. A proprietary binary command is used in writing the IMEI into the firmware where it is stored in a separate file within the flash file system. There is no user accessibility to the IMEI file and as an additional safeguard it is only possible to write the IMEI number once into the flash memory.
