Through the FCC KBD Inquiry system, we requested a SAR test exemption for our Low-Duty Factor utilization of our Wi-Fi product feature.

The request was subsequently granted by the FCC and we now make the following attestation statement regarding such:

"As both a device manufacturer & service provider, we shall throttle the Wi-Fi transmitted data as needed to ensure that we do not exceed the 3.94% duty factor requirement as published & approved by the FCC. This is detailed in FCC Inquiry Tracking Number: 646987."

Additionally, Attenti US, Inc., grants permission to the Application Examiner and TCB to review all attachments and communications associated with FCC Inquiry Tracking Number 646987. It is important to note however that the Attachment submitted to the FCC on 4/19/18 was the final attachment indicated approved by the FCC.
