The Power amplifier used in the unit in the downlink direction is described as a 10W and 5W in the uplink. These amplifiers are used not to produce these levels of power but to ensure good linearity in the multi- carrier environment. It is the third order intercept point we are looking for to ensure the attenuation of unwanted intermodulation products is maximum. In fact the level of each carrier at the output is limited to 28dBm(0.64W) in the downlink and 25dBm(0.32W) in the uplink this is achieved by an individual ALC on each channel.
