- We require permanent confidentiality for Internal Photographs and User Manuel.
 This equipment is a non-consumer device and is permanently mounted and sealed in areas that are not accessible to the general public. The user manual is highly technical and is only provided to the customer on a non-disclosure agreement. We attest to items 3 and 4 of the FCC confidentiality policies.

Confidential policies

- 1) Internal photos of a consumer device may be held confidential when the circuit board is enclosed in epoxy or in a material that would destroy the circuit board if removed.
- 2) Internal photos of a consumer device may be held confidential if the device is sealed and disassembly would destroy the product.
- 3) Internal photos can also be held confidential if a non-consumer device is inaccessible to the general public, such as a device mounted on the top of a large tower (or in a fenced enclosure) that is only serviceable by the licensee or his designated technicians.
- 4) A user's manual may be held confidential when the manual is very technical and is not provided to the consumer because the consumer cannot service the device.

These materials contain trade secrets and proprietary information and are not customarily released to the public. The public disclosure of this information might be harmful to the company and provide unjustified benefits to our competitors.
