Question #2: This is a mobile device, please add the following RF exposure statement into the user manual: "The antenna(s) used for this transmitter must be installed to provide a separation distance of at least 20 cm from all persons". Also 5.15-5.25GHz band is restricted to indoor use only. Please add warning statement into the manual as well.

Ans: The userman had been revised and added warning statment into it as attachment.

Question #3: Please separate MPE calculation from UNII report and submit as an independent document. In future, please always submit a separate document to address RF exposeure requirement for all UNII applications.
