- 1. Tune your video receiver to 916.5 MHz
- 2. Connect power adapter at "Connector A".
- 3. Connect a video source to the transmitter at "Connector B".
- 4. The transmitted picture should now be seen on the monitor.
- 5. For best results make sure that the antenna is not obstructed.
- 6. IMPORTANT! Using the TC-900 closer than 10 feet to the receiver may result in a distorted picture.
