Letter of Transmittal for ECH Series of Fluorescent Lamps (amended 11/12/99)

The change being requested is a broadening of the product line through addition of an additional series of lamps having different housings to accommodate specific applications. These lamps do not have a screw in base as the original submission, but pigtail wires that can be hard wired into a fixture or housing. The circuit boards have different physical configurations to fit the housings but contain the same components arranged in the same ways. There are no changes in the frequency determining and stabilizing circuits. The operating frequency of 0.045 mHz remains the same. The components vary in the same manner as those of the original grant and are shown in the various schematics. The emissions of individual lamps vary from those of the original submission and from each other, but all meet the requirements of the FCC Part 18 as shown in the test reports. Thus, this is believed to be a Class II permissive change.
