2. Connecting the OTT BOX

Follow below instruction:

- 1. Connect HDMI cable from OTT Box to TV
- 2. Plug-in DC connector to OTT Box
- 3. Plug-in AC plug

4. FCC and SAFETY STATEMENT

FCC Statement:
