- 1) The responsible party located on the DoC information sheet must be located within the U.S. Please provide a corrected copy of the DoC statement that references a U.S. Based responsible party, or if this is yet to be determined, then fill in with "U.S. based responsible party yet to be determined."
- 2) The <u>operational description & Section 6 of the RF Exposure Exhibit</u> explain the device is to be used with 2.5 cm spacing. The device may be used as a general purpose PCMCIA card in a variety of devices including laptops & PDA's, etc. (some of these devices may be used in the lap or while on the body). Therefore touch position IS considered applicable and the device must be subject to portable exposure conditions (2.5 cm separation distance is NOT considered applicable). Please correct these exhibits as appropriate.
- 3) Please explain if this device is designed for simultaneous transmit in both bands of operation or not.
