Acer NeWeb Corporation requests that certain materials submitted with this application for certification of the Model WARPLINK 2401 Spread Spectrum Wireless LAN transceiver be withheld from public disclosure. This request is made under the provision of Section 0.457 (d) of the Commission's Rule and Section 552 (b) (4) of the Freedom of Information Act, Trade Secrets.

The envelope marked "Confidential" contains detailed block diagrams, schematic diagrams, and a detailed theory of operation submitted to the FCC for review with this application. The information in this envelope contains proprietary information (trade secrets) regarding this product, which are the result of our extensive investment in research and development. Without the disclosed information, our competitors would take considerable more time to assess and develop a workable competitive product. As a result, we believe that disclosure of these company-guarded materials would compromise our leading position in this market.

We therefore formally request that the materials contained in this envelope be kept strictly confidential and not made available for inspection by any other party, except on a need to know basis for the sole purpose of the certification process.
