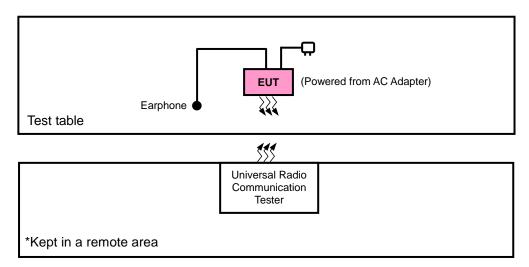

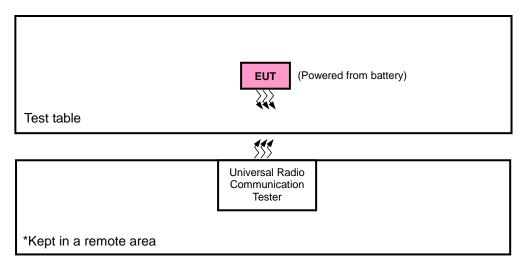

4 TEST TYPES AND RESULTS

4.1 OUTPUT POWER MEASUREMENT

4.1.1 LIMITS OF OUTPUT POWER MEASUREMENT

Mobile / Portable station are limited to 7 watts e.r.p.

4.1.2 TEST PROCEDURES

EIRP / ERP MEASUREMENT:

- a. All measurements were done at low, middle and high operational frequency range. RBW and VBW is 1MHz for GSM, GPRS & EDGE, 5MHz for WCDMA and CDMA mode.
- b. Substitution method is used for E.I.R.P measurement. In the semi-anechoic chamber, EUT placed on the 0.8m height of Turn Table, rotated the table around 360 degrees to search the maximum radiation power and receiver antenna shall be rotated vertical and horizontal polarization and moved height from 1m to 4m to find the maximum polar radiated power. The "Read Value" is the spectrum reading the maximum power value.
- c. The substitution horn antenna is substituted for EUT at the same position and signals generator export the CW signal to the substitution antenna via a tx cable. Rotated the Turn Table and moved receiving antenna to find the maximum radiation power. Adjust output power level of S.G to get a Value of spectrum reading equal to "Read Value" of step b. Record the power level of S.G
- d. EIRP = Output power level of S.G TX cable loss + Antenna gain of substitution horn.E.R.P power can be calculated form E.I.R.P power by subtracting the gain of dipole, E.R.P power = E.I.R.P power 2.15dBi.

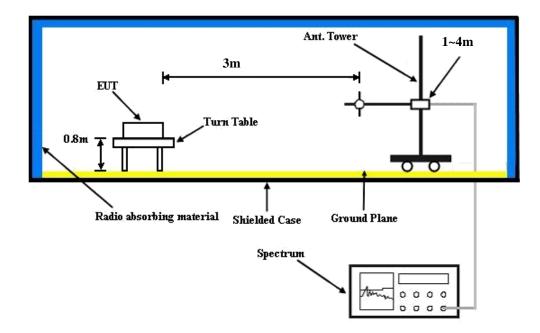

4.2.1 LIMITS OF FREQUENCY STABILITY MEASUREMENT

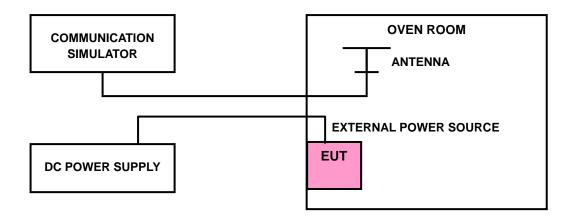
1.5 ppm is for base and fixed station. 2.5 ppm is for mobile station.

4.2.2 TEST PROCEDURE

- a. Device is placed at the oven room. The oven room could control the temperatures and humidity. Power warm up is at least 15 min and power applied should perform before recording frequency error.
- b. EUT is connected the external power supply to control the DC input power. The test voltage range is from minimum to maximum working voltage. Each step shall be record the frequency error rate.
- c. The temperature range step is 10 degrees in this test items. All temperature levels shall be hold the ± 0.5 °C during the measurement testing. The each temperature step shall be at least 0.5 hours, consider the EUT could be test under the stability condition.

NOTE: The frequency error was recorded frequency error from the communication simulator.

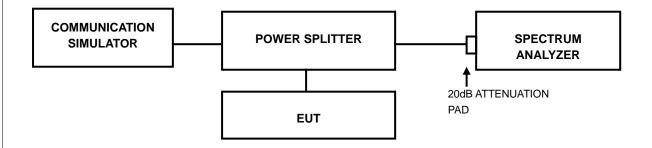


4.3 OCCUPIED BANDWIDTH MEASUREMENT

The EUT makes a call to the communication simulator. All measurements were done at low, middle and high operational frequency range. The communication simulator station system controlled a EUT to export maximum output power under transmission mode and specific channel frequency. Use OBW measurement function of Spectrum analyzer to measure 99 % occupied bandwidth.

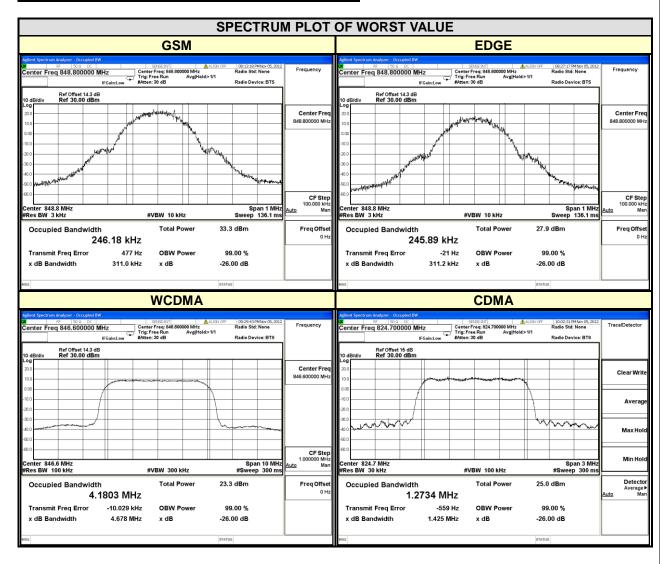

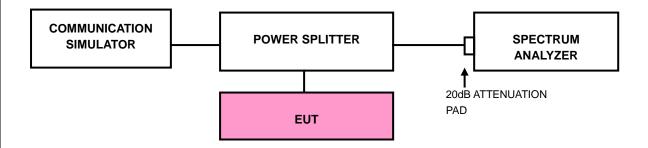

4.4.1 LIMITS OF BAND EDGE MEASUREMENT

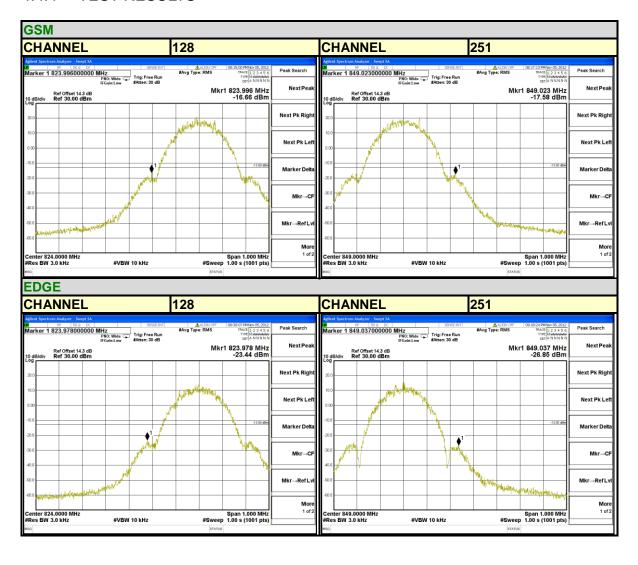

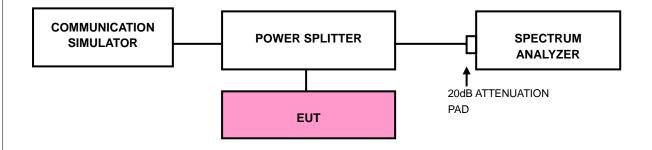
4.5.1 LIMITS OF CONDUCTED SPURIOUS EMISSIONS MEASUREMENT

4.6 RADIATED EMISSION MEASUREMENT

4.6.1 LIMITS OF RADIATED EMISSION MEASUREMENT

The power of any emission outside of the authorized operating frequency ranges must be attenuated below the transmitting power (P) by a factor of at least $43 + 10 \log(P) dB$. The emission limit equal to -13dBm.

4.6.2 TEST PROCEDURES

- a. Substitution method is used for E.I.R.P measurement. In the semi-anechoic chamber, EUT placed on the 0.8m height of Turn Table, rotated the table around 360 degrees to search the maximum radiation power and receiver antenna shall be rotated vertical and horizontal polarization and moved height from 1m to 4m to find the maximum polar radiated power. The "Read Value" is the spectrum reading the maximum power value.
- b. The substitution horn antenna is substituted for EUT at the same position and signals generator export the CW signal to the substitution antenna via a TX cable. Rotated the Turn Table and moved receiving antenna to find the maximum radiation power. Adjust output power level of S.G to get a Value of spectrum reading equal to "Read Value" of step a. Record the power level of S.G
- c. EIRP = Output power level of S.G TX cable loss + Antenna gain of substitution horn.
- d. E.R.P power can be calculated form E.I.R.P power by subtracting the gain of dipole, E.R.P power = E.I.P.R power 2.15dBi.

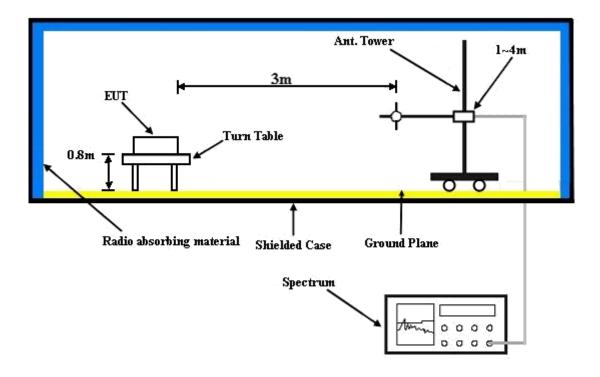
