
Subject: Withdraw the FCC ID for NM8PJ58100

We, **HTC Corporation** hope to withdraw the FCC ID, NM8PJ58100, because this product will not be launched /sold in the America's market and we hope to prevent the impact for the other product in the future by short term confidentiality issue of NM8PJ58100. Therefore, according to our marketing strategy, we have stopped to manufacture this product NM8PJ58100, and stopped all following steps (commercial shipment and selling in the America). The reasons are as following:

- Recently, the smartphone market is varied rapidly. After we, HTC Corporation, got the grant of NM8PJ58100 on Feb. 28th 2012; we found some features of NM8PJ58100 should be more attractive to meet our new marketing strategy. Therefore, we **postponed to produce this product**.
- From March to end of April, we started to discuss internally about what's the next step then we all made a decision that we should **close** this product, NM8PJ58100 for confidential concern.
- Finally, in order to protect our right, we made a decision on May 20th 2012 that we should withdraw the FCC ID, NM8PJ58100 before its short term confidentiality (internal/external/setup photos) is in public disclosure and prevent those be simulated by our competition in the future, because those documents include the outlook design concept (the outlook of Industrial Design), mechanical stacking, PCB placement of NM8PJ58100.

We, **HTC Corporation** hope the commission could approve our request for withdrawing the FCC ID: NM8PJ58100.
