

Start Reading!

Simply select a title to open a book, then use the Navigation Pad to turn pages.

Want to jump forward or back? Press the MENU button and select NEXT CHAPTER OF PREVIOUS CHAPTER, OF SELECT TABLE OF CONTENTS and pick the chapter you want to read.

You can also personalize your reading experience to make reading even more enjoyable. Press the MENU button and select DISPLAY. You can choose from five different type sizes, and two font styles.


You can even change text size as you read by pressing up and down on the Navigation Pad.



RESETTING YOUR EREADER

Unfold a small paperclip and push the end of it into the hole on the back of your eReader until you feel a firm click. This restarts your eReader, which can take 20 seconds.

Getting Started with your Kobo eReader

Insert an SD card (up to 4 GB) to increase the number of books your eReader can store.



Getting to know your Kobo eReader

Power Button

Press and hold for 3 seconds to turn your eReader on and off, or tap to put your eReader to sleep. SD Slot 🔨 Status Indicator Light \frown Red/violet indicates charging.
