## Control Buttons

Escape/Power On/

● Escape/Power On/ - Used to display the Function/Message Read Menu, to turn the pager on, Function Button and to Escape current state.

◀ Left, Right Directional/ - Used to navigate through the Function/Message Read Menu, to preview

▶ Backlight On Buttons your messages, to navigate through time/alarm/auto power on/off setting functions, and to turn the backlight on (press and hold for two seconds).

— Read/Select Button - Used to select a pager function, to activate your selection, to navigate through time/alarm/auto power on/off setting function, and to display message manipulate screen (press for two seconds while reading message).

## 4. Operation

## Turning Your Pager On

Press and hold **●** for two seconds. A start-up screen is displayed and your pager activates the initial alert.

## Turning Your Pager Off

① Press **●** to display the function menu.

② Press **◀** to move the cursor to .

③ Press **■** to turn Pager off.

Your pager is now off and the screen is blank. The buttons are not functioned except **●** button.

If you press **●** shortly, "-POWER OFF-" is displayed with current time and date.

## Backlight

The Backlight is on at any time by pressing and holding **◀** or **▶** for two seconds.

## Using the Function Menu

The Function Menu provides access to the many features of your pager through the use of symbols.

① Press **●** to display the function menu.

The location of the cursor is indicated by inverted symbol.

② Press **◀** or **▶** to move the cursor within the function menu.

As you move through the Function Menu, the function symbols  
Inverted to indicate the present location of the cursor.

③ Press **■** to activate function.

To exit from the Function Menu without making *Example of Function Menu Screen*

any changes or go back to the Message Menu, press **●**.





## Using the Message Read Menu

① Press **◀**, **▶** or **■** to display the message menu.

② Press **◀** or **▶** to move within the message menu

(Private, Notebook and Maildrop).

③ Press **■** to read message.

**Note:**  01 number of unread message(s).  
 03 number of stored messages(s).

*Example of Message Read Menu Screen*



When the memory is full (20 messages), "FULL" is displayed instead of message number.

## Receiving/Reading/Manipulating Personal Messages

Your pager can receive up to 20 personal messages. When a message is received, your pager alerts according to the current alert setting (audible, vibrate, or no alert).

### -Reading an Incoming Message

① Press **■** to display your message. Press **■** again to read the next screen.

② Press **◀** or **▶** to go back to the first screen of the message.

### -Previewing/Reading/Deleting/locking/unlocking/Moving to Notebook a Stored Message


① Press **◀** or **■** to display the message menu.

② Press **■** to display message preview screen. Press **◀** or **▶** to preview the message you want to read.

③ Press **■** to read the detailed message. Press **■** again to read the next screen.

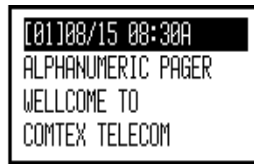
If you want to delete/lock/unlock or move to Notebook the message while reading it, press and hold **■** for two seconds to display Message Manipulate Screen. Press **◀** or **▶** to move the cursor to the desired function, and press **■** to activate it.

- ④ If you want to go back to the preview screen, press ●.

**Note:** When an unread message exists, your pager gives a periodic reminder alert (every 3 minutes) until all unread messages are read. A  on the pager status line indicates that you have unread messages. Reminder alert is enabled or disabled through the Function Menu. Reminder alerts can be turned on or off.

## Display Zoom



When this feature is activated, the standard 4-line (② 20 characters per line) display is converted to a 4-line (③ 15 characters per line) or 8-line (① 20 characters per line) display.

### -To select Display Zoom




- ① Press ● to display the Function Menu.
- ② Press ◀ to move the cursor to ① ② ③ (current setting).
- ③ Press  to select desired zooming step ( ① ② ③ ).

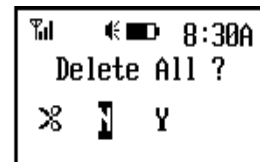
## Deleting Messages

### -To Delete Single Message while Reading It

- ① From the Message Manipulate Screen, press ▶ to move the cursor to .
- ② Press  to delete the message.


### -To Delete All Unlocked Messages

- ① From the Function Menu, press ◀ to move the cursor to .
- ② Press  "Delete All ?" screen is displayed.
- ③ Press ▶ to move the cursor to Y.
- ④ Press . All unlocked messages are deleted.





**Note:** Notebook messages are not deleted with this feature.

## Locking and Unlocking Messages

Up to 10 messages can be locked to prevent them from being deleted or from being replaced when memory is full. When a message is locked, the  symbol displayed on the Time Stamp line while reading the message.

### -To Lock or Unlock a Message while Reading it



- ① From the Message Manipulate Screen, press ▶ to move the cursor to .
- ② Press  to lock or unlock the message.




## Notebooks

Your pager has eight notebook areas for storing personal messages.

### -Storing Personal Messages in Your Notebooks

- ① From the Message Manipulate Screen, press ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor to .
- ② Press . The message is now in the Notebook.

### -Reading/Deleting Messages in Your Notebooks

- ① From the Message Read Menu Screen, press ▶ to move the cursor to .
- ② Notebook messages are read and deleted the same way as personal messages.

**Note:** Notebook messages are deleted one at a time. Storing to notebook is not activated when it is full.

## Maildrop/Information Service

Your pager has eight Maildrop areas (Each area has four rooms for storing maildrop messages).

### -Reading Messages in Your Maildrop

- 1 From the Message Read Menu Screen, press ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor.
- 2 Maildrop messages are read the same way as personal messages.

### -Turning Maildrop Alerts On and Off

- 1 From the Function Menu Screen, press ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor to alert on or alert off.
- 2 Press [Enter] to turn the maildrop alert on or off.



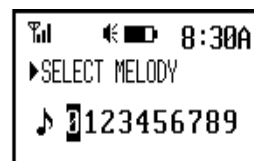
## Setting the Incoming Message Alert

- 1 From the Function Menu, press ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor to [Alert] (current setting).
- 2 Press [Enter] to change the type of alert (audible, vibrate or silent).

**Note:** The current Alert setting [Audible], [Vibrate], [Silent] is also displayed on the pager status line.

### -Setting the Alert Pattern (Tone or Melody)

- 1 From the Function Menu, press ◀ to move the cursor to [Tone/Melody].
- 2 Press [Enter] to display the Select Melody screen.
- 3 Press ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor to desired number.
- 4 Press [Enter] to listen the melody or tone.
- 5 Repeat steps 3 and 4 to select another pattern.



## Setting the Time and Date

- 1 From the Function Menu, press ▶ to move the cursor to [Time/Date].
- 2 Press [Enter] to display the Set Time/Date screen.
- 3 Press ◀ or ▶ to adjust the hour.
- 4 Press [Enter] to move the cursor to next set of digits.
- 5 Repeat steps 3 and 4 to adjust minutes, day/month(or month/day)/year/week.
- 6 Press [Enter] to activate the time and date setting.



## Setting the Alarm

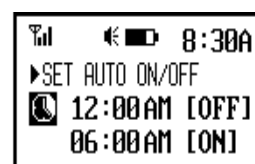
- 1 From the Function Menu, press ▶ to move the cursor to [Alarm].
- 2 Press [Enter] to display the Set Alarm screen.
- 3 Press ◀ or ▶ to enable [On] or disable [Off] alarm.
- 4 Press [Enter] to move the cursor to alarm hour.
- 5 Press ◀ or ▶ to adjust the hour.
- 6 Repeat for minutes.
- 7 Press [Enter] to activate the alarm setting.

**Note:** If alarm is on, the [Alarm] symbol is displayed on the pager status line.



## Setting the Auto Power On/Off

- 1 From the Function Menu, press ▶ to move the cursor to [Auto Power On/Off].
- 2 Press [Enter] to display the Set Auto Power On/Off screen.
- 3 Press ◀ or ▶ to enable [On] or disable [Off] auto-power-on/off.
- 4 Press [Enter] to move the cursor to auto-off hour digits.
- 5 Press ◀ or ▶ to adjust the hour of auto-off time.
- 6 Repeat steps 4 and 5 to adjust the minutes and auto-on time.
- 7 Press [Enter] to activate the auto-power-on/off setting.




## Setting the Time Mode

- 1 From the Function Menu, press **▶** to move the cursor to <sup>12</sup>hour or <sup>24</sup>hour (current setting).
- 2 Press **■** to change the Time Mode to 12 hour time or 24 hour time.

## Setting the Date Mode

- 1 From the Function Menu, press **◀** or **▶** to move the cursor to <sup>D</sup>ay or <sup>M</sup>onth (current setting).
- 2 Press **■** to change the Date Mode to Day/Month/Year or Month/Day/Year.

## Adjusting LCD Brightness

- 1 From the Function Menu, press **◀** or **▶** to move the cursor to .
- 2 Press **■** to display the LCD Brightness screen.
- 3 Press **◀** or **▶** to adjust brightness of LCD display.
- 4 Press **●** to exit.



## Setting the Auto Reset Time (Duration of Display off Time)

- 1 From the Function Menu, press **◀** or **▶** to move the cursor to 12s, 20s, 28s, or 36s (current setting).
- 2 Press **■** to change the Auto Reset Time.

## Battery Information

Your pager is designed to operate with a single AAA-size alkaline battery.

### -Low Battery Indication

When the battery is low, "LOW BATTERY !" is displayed with beeping at every 4 minutes.

### -Replacing the Battery

To replace the battery, proceed as follows:

- 1 Unlock the battery door by sliding the door latch away from the battery door.
- 2 Slide the battery door away from the housing to remove it.
- 3 Remove the old battery and insert new one in the direction shown on the battery compartment.

### -Battery Back-up



Your pager has a backup battery for memory retention during battery replacement.








**Note:** To protect all the memory when you replace the battery, please change old battery to new one quickly. And avoid too much key operation during replacing battery.

### ***Turning Your Pager Off***

- ❶ Press ● to display the function menu.
- ❷ Press ◀ to move the cursor to .
- ❸ Press  to turn Pager off.

### ***Turning Your Pager On***

- ❶ Press ● for two seconds until the Pager turns on.




### ***Using the Function Menu***

- ❶ Press ● to display the function menu.
- ❷ Press ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor within the function menu.
- ❸ Press  to activate function.





### ***Backlighting***

Press ◀ or ▶ for two seconds to activate the backlight.

### ***Setting the Time and Date***



- ❶ Press ● to display the function menu.
- ❷ Press ▶ to move the cursor to .
- ❸ Press  to display the Set-time-and-date screen.
- ❹ Press ◀ or ▶ to adjust the hour.
- ❺ Press  to select next set of digits.
- ❻ Repeat for minutes, day/month(or month/day)/year/week.
- ❼ Press ● to activate the time and date setting.

### ***Setting the Alarm***




- ❶ Press ● to display the function menu.
- ❷ Press ▶ to move the cursor to  or .
- ❸ Press  to display the set-alarm screen.
- ❹ Press ◀ or ▶ to enable or disable the alarm.
- ❺ Press  to select alarm hour.
- ❻ Repeat for minutes.
- ❼ Press ● to activate the alarm setting.

Note:  alarm disabled,  alarm enabled.

### ***Using the Message Read Menu***

- ❶ Press ◀, ▶ or  to display the message menu.
- ❷ Press ◀ or ▶ to move within the message menu (private, notebook and maildrop).
- ❸ Press  to read message.

### ***Receiving and Reading Your Messages***

- ❶ Press any button to stop the alert.
- ❷ Press  to display your message.
- ❸ Press ◀ or ▶ to scan (preview) messages.
- ❹ Press  to view detailed message.
- ❺ Press  again to advance message screen by screen.
- ❻ Press ◀ or ▶ to go back to the first screen of the message.



- ⑦ Press ● to go back to the preview (scan) screen.

### **Deleting/Locking/Unlocking Messages or Adding to Notebook**

- ① Press ■ for two seconds in the message display screen(not preview screen).
- ② Press ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor to desired function.
- ③ Press ■ to activate the function.
