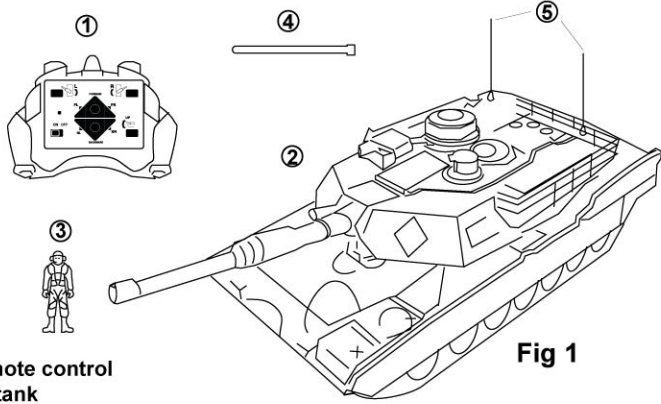

## Warning

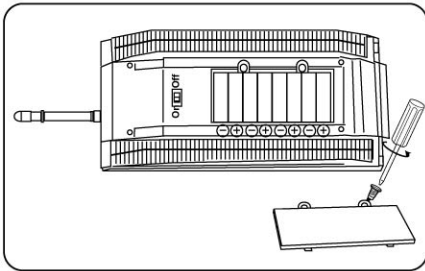
- Adult setup and supervision required at all times.

## Initial Setup & Battery Replacement

Important: Only ADULTS should replace batteries. Replace all included batteries that came with new alkaline batteries upon purchase.

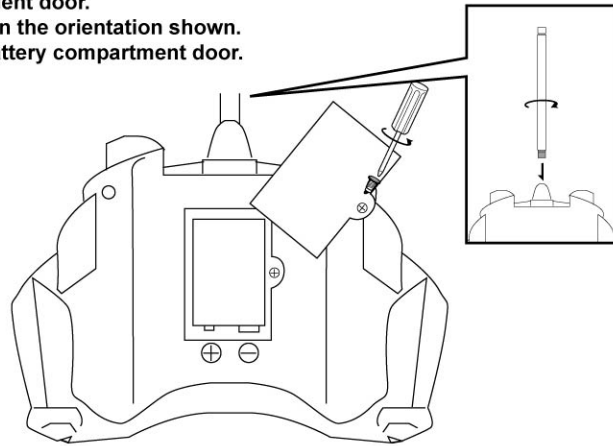
### RC Tank

- Take out the tank from the package (For initial setup only).
- Attach the two metal wire antenna on the RC tank rear as shown in figure 1.
- Loosen screws from in battery compartment door with a Philips / cross head screwdriver (not included).
- Remove battery compartment door.
- Insert 8 x "AA" Alkaline batteries in the orientation shown.
- Replace and secure the battery compartment door.



## Remote Control

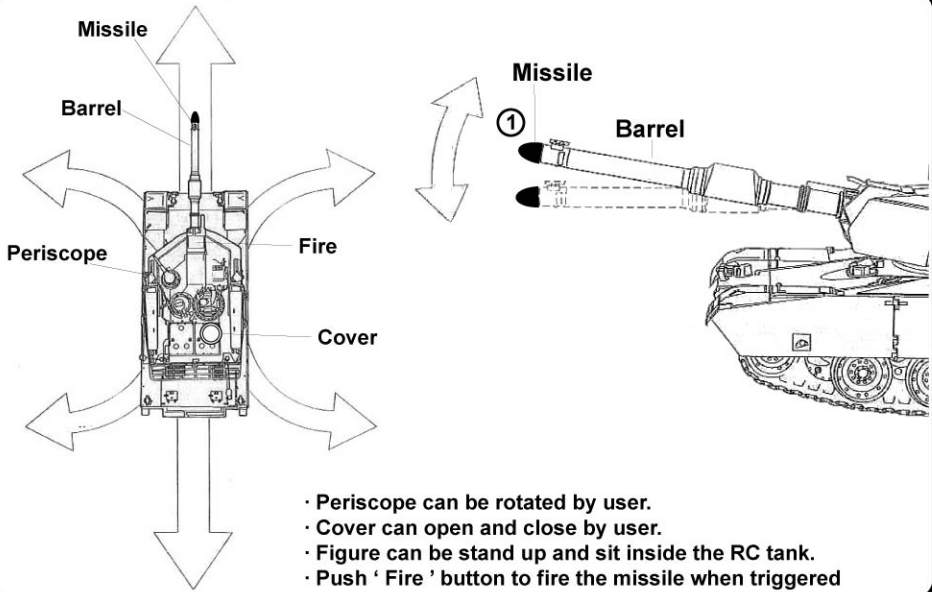
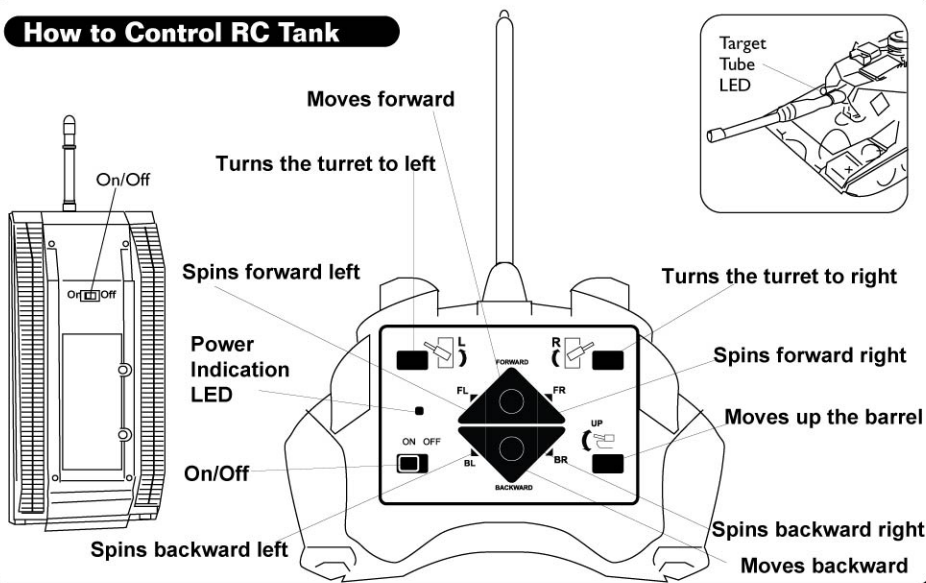
- Take out the remote control from the package (For initial setup only).
- Screw on the metal antenna and extend it to the maximum length.
- Loosen screw from battery compartment door with a Philips / cross head screwdriver (not included).
- Remove battery compartment door.
- Insert 9V Alkaline battery in the orientation shown.
- Replace and secure the battery compartment door.



## How to Power Up RC Tank

- Simply slide the ON/ OFF switch on the RC Tank and remote control to the "On" position.
- The target tube LED lights up to show RC tank is switched on.
- Power indication LED lights up to show remote control is switched on.

## After Use Storage

Remove all batteries before storage.  
NOTE: Always store the product in a dry place. Never leave outside when not in use!

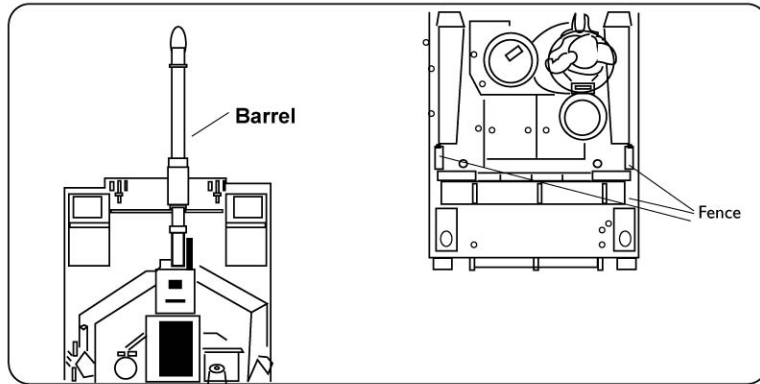

## Battery Warnings

- Important! Only adults should replace batteries.
- Use of alkaline batteries is recommended
  - Do not use rechargeable batteries.
  - Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
  - Do not mix old with new batteries.
  - Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
  - Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
  - Used batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
  - Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
  - The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
  - Please keep this information for future reference.
  - Remove batteries from the product before extended storage.

## Care & Maintenance

- Clean the product (plastic parts) with a damp cloth.
- Do not immerse this toy in water.
- Do not expose product to direct sunlight for long periods of time
- If movements from this toy became weak or slow, please replace the batteries.
- Do not take this toy apart since no serviceable parts are available.
- If the gun barrel or the fences became detached from normal play, simply reinsert the items into their original positions. This is not defective.
- A power protective circuit is inside the RC tank. It shuts down the power when the objects trap the driving wheel causing the motor current drawn high. After a few seconds, It restart automatically.
